

Guide to Remote Learning (Parents)

Preparing for Lock-down:

- School will send home an exercise book in which answers can be written
- Some parents have asked for recommendations for devices – we would suggest Chrome books or Lenovo tablets as they seem to be the most cost effective.

In the event that **one or two bubbles** are closed:

(If more than one bubble is off, teachers will liaise with the parents and class teachers of any siblings to organise live lessons or pre-recorded so both children can access)

Day 1:

10am – teachers will set up a GOOGLE MEET

- ensure all children can access the remote platform,
- check that they are all ok and not anxious about the bubble closure.
- Take register. Mrs Bahsoon will chase up those who do not attend to identify issues.

11am – teachers will launch the ‘Day 1 emergency pack’ which will include tasks and activities for the first day whilst they plan and prepare the rest of the week.

Day 2 and onwards:

9am – registration: take register

Short collective worship

9.30am - 10am –all resources for the day will be uploaded. The teachers may launch all videos by 10 am or if they are doing live sessions, they will be at the times below. This will be communicated on day 1.

10am – **Maths** Maths pre-recorded video **or** a scheduled live MEET.

11am - **SPAG** SPAG pre-recorded video **or** a scheduled live MEET

11.30 – **Phonics / Reading** Upload phonics/reading pre-recorded video **or** a scheduled live MEET

Afternoon.

Teachers will: Respond to messages and uploaded work **as appropriate** (if it needs feedback or support)

Adapt planning for following day based on work submitted

Pre-record some intervention sessions if appropriate

Children can: complete some of the optional tasks or work on the activities from the morning or work on an item from the key skills list.

In the event that **the whole school** is closed:

Day 1:

GOOGLE MEET

- ensure all children can access the remote platform,
- check that they are all ok and not anxious about the bubble closure.
- Take register. Ask Kim to chase up those who do not attend to identify issues.

By 11am – teachers will launch the 'Day 1 pack'

Day 2 and onwards:

Take register (stored on server) at the following times:

12.30pm Year 5
1pm Year 6

9.30am - 10am –upload all resources for the day

10am – **Maths** Upload Maths pre-recorded video

11am - **SPAG** Upload SPAG pre-recorded video

11.30 – **Phonics / Reading** Upload phonics/reading pre-recorded video

Please note – worksheets do not need to be printed; the children can write their answers in the exercise book provided.
