Uniform Requirements.

“As unique individuals, we do our best at work and play for the love of God and others.”

We are proud of our school and we want our children to be proud too. We also know that the discipline instilled in children when they wear uniform translates to all that they do in school.

The expectation is that ALL children wear the correct uniform ALL of the time.

Autumn and Spring term:

- White collared shirt
- Golden tie
- Green cardigan or jumper
- Grey trousers, shorts, pinafore or skirts
- Grey or white socks or tights
- Black school shoes – not trainers.



Summer term:

- Yellow and white checked dress or playsuit
- Or grey shorts or trousers with a yellow polo shirt
- White or grey socks
- Black school shoes – not trainers

PE kit:

Some children still wear the old PE kit which is yellow t-shirt and green shorts. That is acceptable too.

- Black t-shirt with a green stripe and matching skort or shorts
- Hoodies, socks and tracksuit bottoms are also available but not compulsory
- Any style of trainer

Exceptions:

In year 5 and 6 some children will be given purple jumpers – they represent TEAM Benedict.
Some children in year 6 are also allowed to wear a hoodie – they are Sports Ambassadors.

We know that school uniform is expensive and we have a number of pre-loved items available in school. We also have a limited number of items that are new. If you are finding it difficult to pay for new uniform, please contact the school office.

From January we will be encouraging children to wear uniform at all times. We have some items that we will lend to pupils who are not wearing the correct clothes. We will talk to parents about uniform if it is regularly incorrect and we may ask you to bring the correct uniform to school.

We hope you will continue to support us as we try to raise standards across the school by providing the correct uniform for your children.
