

## ST BENEDICT'S CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL

### SPORTS GRANT:

As a result of the Olympic legacy, St Benedict's received £8,775 for 2013 to 2014 and £8800 for 2014 to 2015 to improve Sport and PE in school and contribute to learning about healthier lifestyles.

From the 4th April 2014 it is a requirement that all schools publish details on their websites about how the money has been spent (or will be spent) and what impact the school has seen on pupils' PE and sport participation and attainment as a result, to help ensure that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles.
