

Tuesday 24th March 2020

I have done a brief activity for each of the lessons below. Please do not stress about spending lots of time on each activity. I have tried to make them as practical as possible.

Maths – Understanding the parts of a clock

Use http://mathsframe.co.uk/en/resources/resource/90/itp_clock and talk about what the children can see on the clock. Point out the minute hand, hour hand and second hand. Talk about the 12 numbers around the edge of the clock.

Revise finding o'clock and half past times. These will have been taught in Y1 but the children may have forgotten them. Focus on o'clock times initially. What happens to the hour hand as the minute hand moves to the next hour?

Remind your child about cutting something in half. We cut it in two down the middle. Explain that the clock is in two halves. Demonstrate different half past times. When they feel confident with this, call out different o'clock and half past times for them to find on the clock.

Literacy – expanded noun phrases

Go out in the garden or look out of the window. Ask your child to use some expanded noun phrases to describe the things they can see. Ask your child to write a short description of the things in their garden.
