It has an impact on the quality of their writing and their ability to read and understand maths questions.

PE will take place on a Monday and Thursday, so please make sure your child has a complete PE kit in school on those days. One of our sessions will be outside, so trainers will be necessary. We are trying to encourage the children to become more independent at fastening buttons, tying shoe laces and tying their ties, so any practice you can do at home would be greatly appreciated.

Please send a water bottle in to school every day. We will help the children to refill their bottles throughout the day.

Please ensure your child is wearing the correct school uniform. Earrings and trainers are not part of our school uniform and should not be worn to school.

It is important to us that we work together as a partnership to develop each child, so if you have any concerns at all, please do not hesitate to come and speak to us. We realise it is often difficult to speak to us before and after the school day. If you would like to leave a message at the office, we will contact you as soon as we are able too.
