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| Literacy and communication  | Keep a diary of some of the things you have been doing whilst being in 'lock down'. | Choose a favourite book and write a book review about it. Write a brief description of what happens in the story. What do you like/dislike about the book? Would you recommend it to a friend? | Choose two books to read. List the ways they are similar. List the ways they are different. |
